PGA of America Hosts Defending Champion Amy Yang for KPMG Women's PGA Championship Media Day at PGA Frisco

The first women's Major Championship to be played at PGA Frisco is set for June 19-22

FRISCO, Texas (June 2, 2025) – The PGA of America today hosted Media Day for the 2025 KPMG Women's PGA Championship at PGA Frisco – the Home of the PGA of America, Omni PGA Frisco Resort, and the PGA District – with defending Champion Amy Yang.

The KPMG Women's PGA Championship will be held June 19-22, marking the first women's Major Championship to be contested at Fields Ranch East at PGA Frisco. This year's Championship is the first of two scheduled for PGA Frisco as Fields Ranch East will host the KPMG Women's PGA Championship again in 2031.

"The reason I like this Championship is because the greatest players in the world play inside the ropes. I see it, you're going to see it two weeks from today, but I think you need to look outside the ropes," said PGA of America President Don Rea Jr., PGA Master Professional and Owner/Operator of Augusta Ranch Golf Club (Arizona). "It's a Major. No doubt about that. But it has a major impact in the community, which for us is just as important."

Yang, alongside her caddie Jan P. Meierling, started her day with a practice round on Fields Ranch East at PGA Frisco. The defending Champion received a first look at the course playing with Paul Earnest, PGA Director of Golf & Operations at Fields Ranch at PGA Frisco, and Trish Holt, PGA Head Golf Professional at Fields Ranch at PGA Frisco.

"The course is playing tough but still fair. I think it's going to test all aspects of your game," said Yang. "I can't wait to come back and play the Championship."

A fireside chat followed, featuring Yang, PGA of America President Don Rea Jr., Championship Director Jason Mengel, General Chair Ashley Miller, and PGA of America Golf Professional Katelyn Sepmoree, PGA Assistant Professional at Willow Brook Country Club in Tyler, Texas, who will be competing in this year's KPMG Women's PGA Championship as a member of the Corebridge Financial Team. Sepmoree is one of 10 PGA/LPGA Professionals on the Corebridge Financial Team who qualified to compete in the Championship through the LPGA Professionals Championship or the PGA Women's Stroke Play Championship.

"I've played the game my whole life, so I had a good jump start there. But I work with really

great people that allow me to do both my job and practice at the same time,” said Sepmoree. “Willow Brook is a really unique spot. They're super supportive of me playing. My head pro, Chris Hudson, has said ‘I want you to chase your dreams, and if that's playing in major championships, then let's find a way to go do that.’ So I'm very blessed to be in a spot that kind of nurtures that.”

Yang and Sepmoree finished their day at PGA Frisco by hitting ceremonial tee shots towards the Championship's 9th green from the rooftop pool deck of the Omni PGA Frisco Resort to celebrate the upcoming Championship.

“Today marked another exciting milestone as we prepare for the 2025 KPMG Women's PGA Championship,” said Mengel. “Every detail is coming together to create an unforgettable KPMG Women's PGA Championship experience for players and spectators alike. We cannot wait to welcome the world's best women players to Fields Ranch East at PGA Frisco in just two weeks.”
