



YMCA of Central Texas and City of Georgetown Break Ground on New \$36M Sport Clips Family YMCA

The 55,000-square-foot facility expected to open in late 2027

GEORGETOWN, Texas (May 29, 2026) — The YMCA of Central Texas, alongside the City of Georgetown, community leaders, donors, and development partners, today celebrated the groundbreaking of the new Sport Clips Family YMCA in Georgetown. The project will expand health, wellness, recreation, and community programming opportunities for residents of all ages.

Located in one of the fastest-growing areas in the United States, the new facility will serve as a hub for youth development, family engagement, healthy living, and senior wellness programming. The project reflects a collaborative \$36 million investment from the YMCA of Central Texas, the Georgetown YMCA Founders Group, the City of Georgetown, Sport Clips, and community partners, including H-E-B, the W.D. Kelley Foundation and Georgetown Health Foundation.

The \$36 million project was made possible through a combination of philanthropic support and public investment, including nearly \$6 million raised by the Georgetown YMCA Founders Group, a voter-approved \$10 million City of Georgetown bond, a \$1 million legacy gift from Sport Clips and the Logan family, and contributions from the YMCA of Central Texas and other community partners.

The new YMCA will feature over 55,000 square feet of expanded spaces for youth sports and swim programming, group fitness, wellness activities, programming for older adults, and community gathering areas designed to meet the evolving needs of Georgetown residents for generations to come.

“In addition to a new building going up, this groundbreaking represents an investment in people, families, and the future of Georgetown that has been years in the making,” said Jeff Andresen, President and Chief Executive Officer of YMCA of Central Texas. “The YMCA exists to strengthen communities, and this new facility will allow us to expand programs and services that support individuals of every age and background.”

City officials joined YMCA leadership and community stakeholders during the ceremonial first dig to commemorate the milestone and celebrate the continued growth and momentum within Georgetown.

“The City of Georgetown is proud to partner on a project that prioritizes recreation, wellness, and community connection,” said David Morgan, City Manager for the City of Georgetown. “This new YMCA will create meaningful opportunities for residents while serving as a gathering place for our growing community.”

The Sport Clips Family YMCA is expected to become a cornerstone community asset, offering inclusive programming and resources for children, teens, adults, seniors, and families throughout the region.
