Unveil Landmark Adventure Destination for Central Texas Families**

AUSTIN, Texas (June 12, 2026) — The YMCA of Central Texas, in partnership with Williamson County, today celebrated the official ribbon-cutting of The Orr Family Sky Trail and The Avery Family Pavilion at the Twin Lakes Family YMCA, completing a nearly \$12 million expansion made possible through collaborative investment in outdoor recreation and community spaces for Central Texas families.

Supported by a \$6 million investment from Williamson County alongside community donors and partners, the project expands outdoor recreational access and creates a new regional destination for families across Cedar Park and surrounding communities.

Community members, partners, and local leaders gathered to experience the new amenities ahead of a busy summer season.

“This project reflects what is possible when community partners come together around a shared vision for families and future generations,” said Jeff Andresen, CEO, YMCA of Central Texas. “We are incredibly grateful for Williamson County’s partnership and support in helping bring these recreational spaces to life, and we are thrilled to officially open them to families across Central Texas.”

The Orr Family Sky Trail features multi-level climbing elements, zip experiences, and adventure-based activities designed for participants of all ages. The Avery Family Pavilion introduces an 11,858-square-foot covered gathering space with an outdoor deck and flexible event space for year-round programming, celebrations, and community events.

“These new amenities represent a major investment in quality of life and outdoor recreation opportunities for Williamson County residents,” said Cynthia Long, Commissioner, Williamson County. “We are proud to partner with the YMCA of Central Texas on a project that will serve families throughout the region for years to come.”

Enhancing the family experience, a new Sky Tykes Area, a dedicated space designed specifically for younger children to explore and play safely, was also added and is currently available for donor naming.

Together, the new facilities create a hub for outdoor engagement, recreation, and social connection in Williamson County. With the facilities opening Saturday, the new additions position the Twin Lakes Family YMCA as a premier outdoor destination for families in Cedar Park and surrounding communities throughout the summer and beyond.
